Bakery: You will find on the road of Haguenau, Boulangerie Kayser, witch gives you the opportunity to experience the specialty of the village: The Bürebrot 1870, backed every Saturday.

Fleckenstein: Located after Lembach, about fifteen km from Morsbronn-les-Bains, on the border with the Palatinate region, you will discover the ruins of Flenckenstein, with the Castle of the challenges, and the petit Fleck; play and discovering area, for all ages.

The War of 1870: You will find near Morsbronn-les-Bains, a lot of remains, monuments, graves, dating from the 1870 war, do not hesitate to request informations.

Times: Meal times are from 7.00 to 10.00 am on weekdays and from 8.00 to 10.00 on weekends for breakfast, from 12.00 to 13.45 for lunch and from 19.00 to 20.45 for dinner. The restaurant is closed on Sunday evening.

Uberach: In Uberach you will find various local handicraft products like beer in the Brasserie Artianale of and "eaux de vies" in the Uberach brandy distillery Hepp and his Alsacian whiskey of Scottish quality.

Wines: Our wine list offers a wide range of local products and other regions of France, as well as different quality wines, served by the glass to accompany your dishes respectively.

Woerth: Head of Canton, this is where you will find the museum of the battle of 1870, with a copy of the fresco of Detaille supposed to represent the town hall of Morsbronn-les-Bains.during the battle of Morsbronn.

Absolutely to visit the pottery in Northern Alsace, in villages like Soufflenheim and Betschdorf. (Pottery Fortuné Schmitter in Betschdorf)

The last things but not the least one to visit in the region, is the wine cellar of Cleebourg, fully renovated, which allows you to taste the grapes grown in the north of Alsace and to compare with vines in the south. In the wake of a visit the town of Wissembourg, worth a detour.
